

By plane


Take a flight into Munich, Franz-Josef-Strauss airport (MUC). From there, travel by public transport or by car. We will also provide timed shuttle options.

By public transport

From the airport, take commuter train S8 to the main station "Hauptbahnhof" (45 min). There, take a train to Garmisch-Partenkirchen (90 min). In Garmisch, take a taxi (15 min) or a bus (45 min) to Eibsee.

By car

It takes approximately one hour from Munich to "Eibsee" by car on the A95. From Garmisch-Partenkirchen via Grainau, it takes only 10 minutes.
